5.1.3 Window Replacement & Repairs

Engagement of Contractors Task Order Contracts WHEREAS, as per the Regulation respecting certain service contracts of public bodies, the Sir Wilfrid Laurier School Board may enter into a task order contract with one or more service providers when the procurement requirements are recurrent and the number of requests, the rate or the frequency at which they are to be performed are uncertain;

WHEREAS, as per said regulation, if the task order contract is entered into with several contractors, the performance requests are made to the contractor who submitted the lowest price, unless the contractor cannot perform the contract, in which case the other contractors are solicited according to their respective rank;

WHEREAS a public call for tenders was made for a window repairs and replacement task order contract and tenders were subsequently opened on October 7, 2020;

WHEREAS the conformability of all bidders was verified by the Material Resources and Transportation Department;

WHEREAS the task order contract will be in effect as of November 16, 2020 until June 30, 2023;
